## ORDINANCE NO. 83-27

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS THAT ARE TO BE ACTED UPON BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHATHAM, ILLINOIS, that the following will be the policy regarding Ordinances and Resolutions that are to be acted upon by the President and Board of Trustees;

Section 1. All Ordinances and Resolutions to be presented to the Board for action at a regular meeting shall be filed in writing with the Village Clerk on or before the tenth(10th) day preceding the meeting at which they are to be acted upon.

Section 2. The Village Clerk shall cause copies thereof to be made and delivered to each member of the Board on or before five (5) days prior to such meeting.

Section 3. It shall not be necessary to read at length the complete text of such Ordinances and Resolutions to the membership of the Board of Trustees present when the same are presented for action, but the same may be referred to in general terms, or by title only, unless a member of the Board of Trustees shall specifically request that the same be read at length.

Section 4. In the event of an emergency, the Board of Trustees may waive this Ordinance provision with a two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage approval and publication as provided for the law.
